Read this *Health, Life and You* Planning Guide and the enclosed Wellness 2000 Welcome Guide to learn how Schlumberger benefits can help you and your family. Look over Your Personal Map for Online Enrollment, which you'll be receiving soon, to become familiar with the Schlumberger Automated Benefits Link (SABL). Then log on, get your personalized information about plan options, and make your choices.

► **If you are a new employee...**

Don't delay! You must enroll within 31 days of your date of hire.

► **If you have previously enrolled in benefits...**

You'll find Schlumberger benefits are now redesigned to give you wider choices, greater tax savings and more value. The new plans go into effect January 1, 2000. Even if you're currently enrolled, you must make your benefit choices during annual enrollment this October. Your choices must be made on SABL — there are no paper enrollment forms.

Important: No previous elections carry over to the new year. Coverage under your current elections expires December 31, 1999. If you do not reenroll, you will be given a limited amount of default coverage, and this may not be a good fit for you and your dependents.

► **Save these enrollment materials,**

as well as Your Personal Map for Online Enrollment and Wellness 2000 Welcome Guide, and share them with your family members. They give you quick references to Schlumberger health, life and disability plans.

► **Need to make a change during the year?**

See page 22 for information on making changes when you have a life event such as marriage, divorce, change in student or work status, or adding or losing a dependent. Also included is information on continuing coverage when you are no longer eligible for the Schlumberger plans.
